

GEDC prepares 2020-2023 Strategic Plan and Public Roadmap

We celebrated our 30th anniversary in 2018; despite the longevity of the organization we strive to not become complacent in our endeavours. We consult with stakeholders and partners to gain input and feedback for new initiatives within our mandate. This process is executed in tandem with the review of previous plans and report recommendations.

Three Strategies used as essential reference during the process were: 2016-2019 Corporate Strategic Plan (internal) with public roadmap; 2017 BR+E Recommendation & Strategy Report; and the 2018-2020 Investment Fund Strategic Plan (internal).

The 2019 Strategic Planning Sessions led to the development of the internal Corporate Strategic Planning Session Report with assigned goals and strategies supported by measures and targets. In addition, a public roadmap brochure (above picture shows the inside panel) was developed outlining GEDC's Goals and Strategies.

The Strategic Sessions were held in two parts on May 27, 2019: a morning session with Stakeholders and Partners and an evening session with GEDC Board and Staff.

Both groups proceeded with identifying the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and gaps of the GEDC. The organizations proceeded to derive projects/activities associated from the strengths, opportunities and gaps identified in the modified SWOT exercise.

By attending the strategic planning session, the participants became aware of the GEDC projects/activities and their relationship to each of their own organizations mandate. Partners will be able to conduct similar strategic planning sessions and avoid duplicate programming and provide pertinent resources to larger projects affecting multiple organizations in Greenstone.

These loans are ideal for smaller businesses looking for help with start-up and other costs.


General Loans: \$10,001 - \$150,000

GEDC's general loans can help Greenstone businesses of all sizes reach their maximum potential.

Pool Loans: \$150,001 - \$500,000

These loans are available through the CFDC's Northwestern Ontario Investment Pool.

GEDC's 3-Tier Lending Program was developed to assist new and existing small to medium enterprises (SME) to finance start-up, maintenance, expansion, purchase of assets or working capital.
