Following a brief lunch networking session the keynote speaker SNC Lavalin, gave a presentation on the new report being launched by GEDC.

SNC Lavalin was retained to develop an Economic Development Study for GEDC. The purpose was to identify the opportunity for, and type of business expansion that could be expected in the Greenaround stone region planned economic activity. For example; Greenstone Gold Mines Projects, Northland Power 300MV Project, Transmission Line

Upgrades, Energy East Pipeline.

The cumulative impact of these projects can provide a significant boost to the local economy, as a result this study was developed to provide the tools to GEDC to be adaptive to changes in regional development, and be able to guide it's local businesses and suppliers to be most effective. One such tool is the economic Development Model which relies on the analysis of base information relating to the projects start date, duration and cost. It allows a review of scenarios including—probability of project development, varying capital investment values, and estimate for economic leakage rates out of the Municipality of Greenstone. Business Outreach Initiative



GEDC and the Municipality of Greenstone launched the Business Outreach Initiative in spring 2016. The goal of the initiative is to have face to face discussions with local businesses to raise awareness, get feedback and provide information on available services.

To date, there have been over 100 business meetings and follow-ups done in the communities of Nakina, Beardmore, Jellicoe and Geraldton. The Longlac area is next on the schedule and it is anticipated that the rest of the outreach meetings will be concluded within the next couple of months. So far there have been a number of

meaningful discussions and follow-up to inquiries. There have also been a number of business directory updates including some new listings, which is one of the many services that are promoted through this Initiative.

Not-for-profit corporations are organizations that provide products or services without making profit. They are generally dedicated to activities that improve or benefit a community. A not-for-profit may generate revenue, but only if the revenue goes back into the organization to further its aims and projects.
