Definitions

Arm's Length is described as a relationship where persons act independently of each other or who are not related.

Active Role in Strategic Decision Making refers to being involved in elements related to the establishment of priorities, objectives and goals of the business and overall operations of the business.

Day to Day Decision Making refers to being involved in elements related to the financial management, human resources, supply management, logistics or customer service day to day operations.

LAMBAC is legally LaCloche Manitoulin Business Assistance Corporation.

Long-Term Control and Management of the Business is defined as having been engaged in the operation, management and ownership of the business for at least two years.

Women Led Business is defined as an enterprise led by a woman (or women) with long-term control and management of the business, equity stake and an active role in both strategic and day to day decision making.

Women Owned Business is defined as one that is at least 51% owned, operated and controlled on a daily basis by one or more female Canadian citizens.

NOW Program Objective

The **NOW** Program's objective is to stimulate women-owned and women-led business start-ups and scale-ups in Northern Ontario.

The **NOW** Program was developed to assist female entrepreneurs with accessing one-time professional services they might not typically be able to afford and to assist with the financial burden of setting up mentoring relationships.

** The NOW Program does not fund capital expenditures (purchase of property, equipment, etc) nor does it fund ongoing professional fees **
